

# Make sure you are install ready.

Now that we've called to schedule your installation, check out these tips to make connecting your home a breeze.

**PLACE HIGH UP**  
Most routers spread their strongest signals downward. Place it high up to maximize coverage and minimize obstructions.



**PLACE IN CENTRAL LOCATION**

Place your router in the center of your home and away from outside walls to distribute the signal evenly.



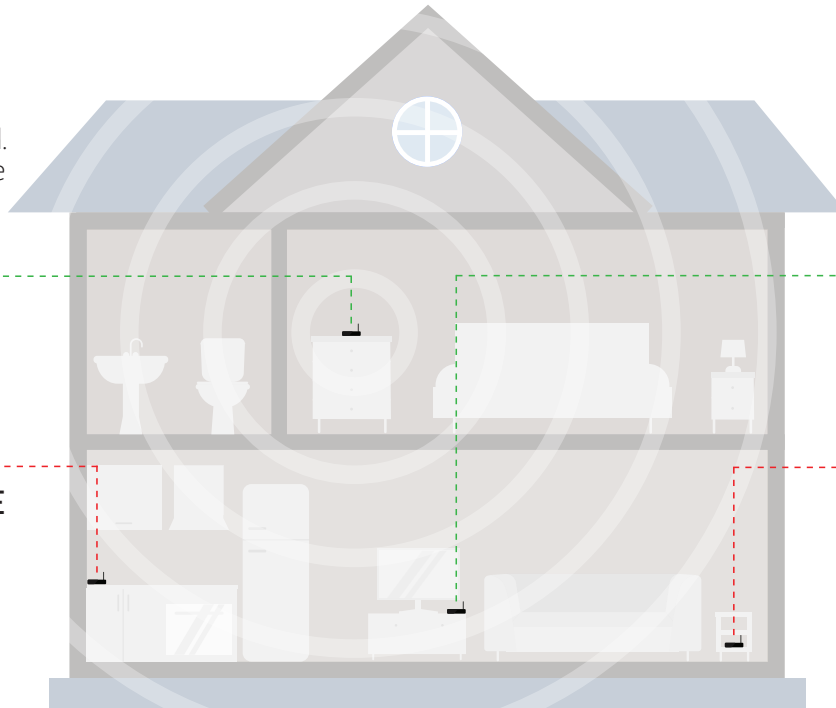
**DON'T PLACE IN THE KITCHEN**

The kitchen is full of metal objects that can interfere with your Internet signal. Try to keep your router away from this area.



**DON'T PLACE IN OR UNDER FURNITURE**

The more barriers your signal must travel through, the weaker your connection will be.



## CHOOSE AN INSTALL LOCATION

The modem is the heart of the system. Place it close to a power outlet in a centralized location for the best coverage.

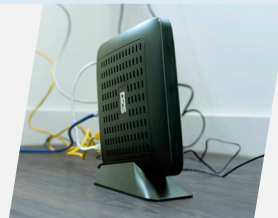

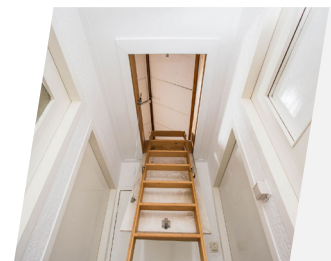
## CLEAR THE PATHWAY

For a fast installation, have an idea of where you want the router installed. Before the technician arrives, move any furniture or fragile items out of the pathway.

Does your home have an attic or crawl space access? Will the fiber need to come through an exterior wall? Our technicians will look for a path that makes the most sense and is the least intrusive, but it helps if you know what you want.
